Arts in Prescot, encompassing the Prescot Festival, is a not-for-profit organisation, run by volunteers to benefit the entire community. It has a written constitution and a broad base of volunteers known as the Friends of the Festival. 2019 marks the 15th Annual Prescot Festival of Music & the Arts.
